WEATHER IN OKINAWA


Okinawa has Subtropical Oceanic climate. It can be quite chilly in winter time. You may experience an unexpected rain shower anytime of the day and anytime of the year.

Follow along the rocky river bed. It is a short hike but pretty easy for everyone and fun! Be prepared for a dive after a hike!




CAPE HEDO
